## Prayer Requests for Our VBS Missionaries — Don & Laura Traub

1. Pray for Chinese seekers who come to their home to feel welcome and at ease and that they will understand and believe the Good News.
2. Pray for new Chinese believers to grow in their faith.
3. Pray for the more Chinese mature believers to become disciple-makers.
4. Pray for opportunities to meet new Chinese seekers, eager to learn what the Bible says and for them to always feel comfortable asking questions (Asking questions when learning is NOT usually culturally acceptable in Chinese culture).
5. Pray for their other role in the organization they partner with, the **English Language Institute (ELI)**, that provides logistical, spiritual and emotional support to teachers throughout Southeast Asia.
6. Praise the Lord for their safe travels to NB, TX and for the opportunity that they get to serve at our VBS and share their heart for missions with our VBS kids, specifically the 5/6th graders this week during Bible time lessons. (Pray for our VBS 5/6th graders hearts to be receptive and teachable as they talk about missions in their classroom.) Pray for their time in the USA to be refreshing and encouraging, for them as a couple, for travel mercies this summer in the various places they visit, and for God's continued financial provision to support their living and ministry needs while they continue to live and serve in Chiang Mai.

## Prayer Requests for Our VBS Missionaries — The White Family

1. Pray for the Whites as they serve with the **Free Burma Rangers (FBR)** to bring help, hope, and love to oppressed people.
2. Pray for God's guidance as they are ambassadors for Christ, as their family not only seeks to love people through conflict zone relief work, but also as they encourage and help strengthen fellow believers who are also working with this mission in Southeast Asia, where they currently live.
3. Pray for "The Good Life Club program", which is the component of FBR that focuses on serving the spiritual and emotional needs of children in the conflict zones of Burma.
4. Pray for the people of Burma to have endurance, protection, hope, and ultimately freedom in Christ. Pray that the oppressive Burma army would surrender and stop killing their own people.
5. Pray for physical and moral courage — volunteers with the FBR must have the physical strength and endurance to be able to walk to crisis areas, and the moral courage to stand with those under attack. Pray specifically for Travis (Mr. White) as he is away from his family for days, weeks, or even months during missions — for not only his physical strength and endurance, but also for his mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being to rely on the Lord for all he needs while he is away from his family serving others.

6. Pray for their family as a whole, but specifically for Cassandra (Mrs. White) and their 6 children of various ages as they homeschool daily and sometimes are without Travis (daddy/husband) for days, weeks, or even months when he goes on missions to the front lines to provide medical care to oppressed people. Pray for God to give peace and comfort to Cassandra and their 6 kids when Travis is not at home and for encouragement for them during these times, and for God's continued financial provision to support their living and ministry needs while they live in Southeast Asia.
